



Popcorn Flower  
Farmhouse  
Granny Square

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## Materials

- Light DK weight yarn (any color of your choice)
- Crochet hook 4-4.5 mm (US size G6-7)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle (for weaving in ends)

## Abbreviations

- ch - chain
- st - stitch
- dc - double crochet
- sl st - slip stitch

## Measurements

The finished granny square measures 13 x 13 cm (approximately 5 x 5").  
The finished size will depend on yarn weight, hook size and tension.

## Instructions

### Round 1.

- Start with a magic ring. (Alternatively, ch 4 and sl st to form a ring.)
- Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1), dc, ch 1—repeat 6 more times.
- Sl st to the top of the starting ch 3 to join. **(You should have 8 dc with ch 1 spaces between.)**

### Round 2.

- Sl st into the next ch-1 space. Ch 3 (counts as first dc), make 3 more dc in the same space. Remove hook from loop, insert hook into first dc of the group, pull the loop through to form a popcorn stitch.
- Ch 2. Make a popcorn stitch (4 dc, pull loop though first st) in the next ch-1 space, ch 2—repeat 6 more times.
- Sl st to the top of the first popcorn stitch to join. **(You should have 8 popcorn stitches with ch 2 spaces between.)**

### Round 3.

- Sl st into the next ch-2 space. Ch 2 (counts as first part of 3 dc together), 2 dc together into the same space.
- Ch 3 (corner space). 3 dc together into the same space **(corner)**.
- Ch 2, 3 dc in the next ch-2 space, Ch 2 **(side)**
- 3 dc together in the same space, ch 3, 3 dc together into the same space **(corner)**.
- Repeat the last 2 steps around for all 8 spaces.
- Sl st to the top of the first st to join. **(You should have 4 corners.)**

### Round 4.

- Sl st into the next corner space. Ch 2, 2 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together **(corner)**.
- Ch 2, 2 dc into the next ch-2 space, dc in next 3 st, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2 **(side)**.
- 3 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together into the corner space **(corner)**.
- Repeat the last 2 steps around for all sides and corners of the square.
- Sl st into to first st to join the round.

### Rounds 5.

- Sl st into the next corner space. Ch 2, 2 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together **(corner)**.
- Ch 2, 2 dc into the next ch-2 space, dc in next 7 st, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2 **(side)**.
- 3 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together into the corner space **(corner)**.
- Repeat the last 2 steps around for all sides and corners of the square.
- Sl st into to first st to join the round.

### Rounds 6.

- Sl st into the next corner space. Ch 2, 2 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together **(corner)**.
- Ch 2, 2 dc into the next ch-2 space, dc in next 11 st, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2 **(side)**.
- 3 dc together, ch 3, 3 dc together into the corner space **(corner)**.
- Repeat the last 2 steps around for all sides and corners of the square.
- Sl st into to first st to join the round.

Fasten off and weave in the ends with a yarn needle. Block the square if needed for a neater finish.

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
