

# Solid Daisy Granny Square

#### **Materials**

- Aran weight yarn in two colors:
  - Color A: Flower center
  - Color B: Flower petals
  - Color C: Background (square)
- 5mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

## **Abbreviations**

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- dc = double crochet
- tc= treble crochet
- sp = space
- st(s) = stitch(es)

## **Finished Size**

• Approx. 5 inches (12.7 cm) square, depending on yarn tension.

## **Instructions**

## Round 1. Center Circle (Color A)

- 1. Start with a magic ring (or ch 4, sl st into first ch to form a ring).
- 2.Ch 3 (counts as first dc).
- 3. Work 11 dc into the ring. (12 dc total, including starting ch-3).
- 4. SI st to the top of the starting ch-3 to join.
- 5. Fasten off Color A and switch to Color B (Petals).

## Round 2. Petals (Color B)

- 1. Ch 3 (counts as part of first petal).
- 2. In the same stitch, work 2 tc together.
- 3.Ch 2.
- 4. In the next st, work 3 tc together, ch 2.
- 5. Repeat step 4 in each st around. (12 petals total).
- 6. SI st into the top of the first petal to join.
- 7. Fasten off Color B and switch to Color C (Background).

## Round 3. Forming the Square (Color C - Background)

- 1. Join Color C in any ch-2 space.
- 2.Ch 3 (counts as first dc).
- 3. In the same ch-2 space, work 2 dc.
- 4. In the next ch-2 space, work 3 dc.
- 5. In the next ch-2 space, work (3 tc, ch 2, 3 tc) to make the first corner.
- 6. In the next 2 ch-2 spaces, work 3 dc in each.
- 7. Repeat step 5-6 around the square to form the four sides and four corners.
- 8. SI st to the top of the starting ch-3 to join. (You will have 12 st in each side of the square + 4 corners of 2 ch = 56 st total)

# Round 4. Solid Border (Color C - Background)

- 1.Ch 2 or 3 (counts as first dc).
- 2. Work 1 dc in each stitch across the first side, untill you reach the corner space.
- 3. In the corner space, work (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc).
- 4. Repeat working 1 dc in each stitch of the sides, and (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in each corner around.
- 5. SI st to the top of the starting ch-2 to join. (You will have 16 st in each side of the square + 4 corners of 2 ch = 72 st total)

Feel free to continue making you your square as big as you like, using the instructions above. You will have 16 new st for each following rounds.

# **Finishing Touches**

- 1. Fasten off and weave in any loose ends using a yarn needle.
- 2. Block the square if needed to shape it properly.
- 3. Join multiple squares for a blanket, pillow, bag or other projects!

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
