



# Super Solid Granny Square

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## Materials

Aran weight yarn (any color)  
5.0mm (H) crochet hook  
Scissors  
Tapestry needle (for weaving in ends)

## Abbreviations

ch – chain  
sl st – slip stitch  
dc – double crochet  
tc – treble crochet

## Measurements:

4.5" (11.5 cm) The finished size will depend on yarn weight, hook size, tension

## Instructions

### Round 1.

- Start with a magic ring.
- Ch 4 (counts as a tc and creates the first corner).
- Work 3 dc into the circle
- Work a tc into the circle (this forms the second corner).
- 3 dc into the circle.
- Tc into the circle (this forms the third corner).
- 3 dc into the circle.
- Tc into the circle (this forms the fourth corner).
- 3 dc into the circle.
- Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 4. **(16 st including the ch 4)**

### Round 2.

- Ch 4 (counts as first tc), 2 dc into the same st.
- Dc in next 3 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the first corner).
- Dc in next 3 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the second corner).

- Dc in next 3 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the third corner).
- Dc in next 3 st.
- 2 dc into the sl st of previous round (this completes the last corner).
- Join with a sl st. **(32 dc including the ch 4)**

### Round 3.

- Ch 4 (counts as first tc), 2 dc into the same st.
- Dc in next 7 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the first corner).
- Dc in next 7 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the second corner).
- Dc in next 7 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the third corner).
- Dc in next 7 st.
- 2 dc into the sl st of previous round (this completes the last corner).
- Join with a sl st. **(48 dc including the ch 4)**

### Round 4.

- Ch 4 (counts as first tc), 2 dc into the same st.
- Dc in next 11 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the first corner).
- Dc in next 11 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the second corner).
- Dc in next 11 st.
- 2 dc, tc, 2dc in next st. (this creates the third corner).
- Dc in next 11 st.
- 2 dc into the sl st of previous round (this completes the last corner).
- Join with a sl st. **(64 dc including the ch 4)**

Feel free to continue making you your square as big as you like, using the pattern above. You will have 16 new st for each following rounds.

### Finishing Touches

- Weave in ends.
- Block the square for a neater finish.
- Join multiple squares for a blanket, pillow, bag or other projects!

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
